2021 National Jamboree Payments and Refund Policy for Youth and Adult Participants

- The Council contracts for services on behalf of the National Jamboree contingent participants. Your commitment begins when you apply on the National site as an adult or youth participant. The current fee schedule is published and total fees for the event are \$1750 for Youth Participants and Adult Participants (Scoutmaster, 1st, and 2nd Asst. Scoutmaster (or Crew/Ship equivalent), and \$1200 for 3rd Asst Scoutmaster when meeting the age requirements as defined by the National Jamboree Committee.
- Generally, there will be no refund of any money that has been expended on behalf of a jamboree participant unless an acceptable replacement is available and paid up according to the council payment schedule. These expenditures include, but are not limited to national jamboree payments, transportation fees, equipment purchases, and jamboree patches.
- Regardless of the date, as long as there is a youth participant who is an acceptable replacement and that replacement is paid up according to the council payment schedule, and the Council Contingent is FULL, there will be a full refund.
- Regardless of the date, if an adult participant is not appointed as a home troop or provisional troop Scoutmaster, 1st Asst, 2nd Asst, or 3rd Asst Scoutmaster (or equivalent Crew/Ship Advisor), there will be a full refund.
- Exemptions can be considered to allow for partial and full refunds considering hardship circumstances. These circumstances include unforeseen medical problems and a death in the immediate family. Summer School is not a hardship circumstance.
- Refund requests will be considered when an adult participant or parent/guardian of a youth participant submits a refund request in writing to the Jamboree Committee of the Occoneetchee Council advising them of the circumstances of the withdrawal from the 2021 Occoneetchee Council National Jamboree Contingent.
- The adult participant or parent/guardian of the youth participant will be provided with two copies of this policy. Both will need to be signed and dated and returned to the Occoneetchee Council, BSA. The address is: 3231 Atlantic Avenue, Raleigh, NC 20604. Both copies will be signed by a representative of the Council Jamboree Committee and one will be returned to you.
